

# WHAT WOULD \$250 (OR MORE) A MONTH MEAN FOR YOUR FAMILY?



Starting July 15, the new Child Tax Credit offers monthly cash payments to families with children — up to \$300 per child! If you have children under 18, you may be eligible even if you do not usually file taxes or have low/no earnings.

Already filed your taxes or filled out the non-filer portal form? Payments will be deposited into your bank account or be mailed to you automatically.

**You can't get your payments if you don't file your taxes. It's not too late. File now.**

## HOW MUCH WILL MY FAMILY GET FROM THE CHILD TAX CREDIT?

**Children under age 6:** Up to \$3,600 per child

**Children ages 6 to 17:** Up to \$3,000 per child

Get the first half in monthly payments, July-December 2021.

Get the second half — a one-time payment — after filing 2021 taxes.

## DON'T HAVE KIDS?

You may still be eligible for other tax credits and COVID-19 relief payments! File your taxes so you don't miss out.
